**School:**

**Topic:** Pesach

**Aim:** Learning about Dayenu through 21st century learning, motivating and engaging the students to think about what they appreciate about being Jewish.

**Time:** 90 minutes

# IT WOULD HAVE BEEN ENOUGH

How many times do we forget to think and notice all the things that Hashem is doing for us?

Dayenu is a reminder to never forget all the miracles in our lives. Every stage and step of leaving Mitzrayim was full of blessing and every stage and step of our day is full of blessing too. Dayenu helps us refocus and be thankful for the details.


The word Yehudi (Jew) comes from the word Toda - to thank. One of the qualities of being a Jew is to always be appreciative and thankful. Look at the example below of a great Jew from the UK.

***Sir Moses Montefiore (1784-1885).***

**He and his wife were big supporters of Israel and the Jewish community.**

**This was his coat of arms.**

**It reads "Think and Thank". This is what they stood for.**



# THE 15 DAYENUS

Each Dayenu thanks Hashem for a different stage

1. Hashem took us out of Mitzrayim
2. Hashem punished the Egyptians (with the Makkot)
3. Hashem destroyed their idols
4. Hashem killed their firstborns
5. Hashem gave us their wealth
6. Hashem split the sea
7. Hashem took us through on dry land
8. Hashem drowned our enemies in the sea
9. Hashem provided our needs for 40 years in the desert
10. Hashem fed us the Manna/Mon
11. Hashem gave us Shabbat
12. Hashem brought us to Mount/Har Sinai
13. Hashem gave us the Torah
14. Hashem brought us up to the Land of Israel
15. Hashem built us the Holy Beit Hamikdash

Using Ji Tap, create a game that teaches some of the things we thank Hashem for in Dayenu and what Jewish life would be like if we didn't have them.


Once you have completed that, your next challenge is to create a game that shows what you thank Hashem for each day.





## 2. Tap on the Create button



You will then see a screen like this...




Here you use the 'Creation Packs' to select backgrounds and images to make a scene. You can also add text by tapping the 'Aa' button.



3. Once you have created your scene, tap on the green 'Add Activity' button on the top right of the screen.



You will then see a screen like this: Select 'Say something'




4. Your screen will look like this.



Tap the Record button to start recording your introduction. Then again to stop recording. Now press DONE.

5. Create a new picture slide - this time focusing on the Jewish things we wouldn't have if Hashem didn't take us out of Egypt.



6. Repeat step 3 and this time select 'Create a Soundboard'.



With your finger, draw round an item and then tap the blue plus sign. Tap record to teach something. You can also type information too. Repeat this method for each item that you wish to teach about.





7. Now for your personal thankyou part. Repeat step 3 to create your picture but this time write between 3-7 sentences for what you thank Hashem for each day in order. It is good to write an instruction too.

## Tips for this screen:

- Pick a border
- Write your thank you list
- Add pictures
- Add instruction



8. This time when selecting your game type, select 'cut a shape puzzle'. Circle a sentence and then press the blue add button. Drag your sentence away from its original place. To create the same size shape for your next sentence, double tap the first shape - an identical shape should appear. Repeat for all your sentences and when you are finished press DONE.






